Did you know you should keep your important medical information on your refrigerator door? This is the first place first responders look for information when entering the home of a patient who is unresponsive or unable to communicate.

We are now offering **CareCard** – our own File of Life, to have your important medical information and emergency contacts readily available for first responders or visitors to your home.

CareCard is provided for free through your local ambulance service and EMS LifeLink.

***Don't forget – you should review your CareCard information every 6 months! Make sure your health information, medications and emergency contacts are up-to-date.***
